Hospitality Free hospitality (including lodging, full boarding (3 meals) and local

transportation) will be provided to the players from lunch on September 25<sup>th</sup> to the breakfast on September 29<sup>th</sup>. If a player is traveling more than 5 times zones, he is entitled to one (1) additional

#### Playing system:

The tournament will be played as follows.

- 1 Four (4) groups of Round-Robin system, best of seven (7) sets. The group winner and runner-up will advance to the Quarter Finals.
- 2 Quarter Finals and onwards, straight knock-out matches, best of seven (7) sets.

Two (2) tables will be used at the Round-Robin play, one (1) Center Court table will be used from Quarter Finals.
