to 2 teams per event. Therefore, up to 12 entries may be accepted by gender and age category IF THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES ALLOWS THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE TO DO THAT. The decision will be taken immediately after the

date of the final entry deadline.

The Host Association is granted with the double of entries per event.

16. Cancellations:

"Sport cancellations" (nothing to do with hotel arrangements) are accepted until 18 AUG at 12:00 hours (noon). After that time, Penalty Policy will be applied.

17. Changes:

Changes in players' entries are accepted untill the cancellation deadline. After that time, no changes on players' entries nor in team compositions are accepted. If cancellations occurs from that time to the time of the draws and are directly notified to the ITTF Competition Manager, the Jury may decide to accept merging the remaining players (i.e. if one player from team "A" and one player of team "B" of the Association XXX cancel their participation **BEFORE** the draw is made but after the Cancellation deadline, the Jury may accept to merge the remaining players of Team "A" and "B" in one team.). The same applies for doubles.

18. Visas:

If you need a visa, please contact the Organization as soon as possible, so we can assist you with the visa process.

19. Racket Controls:

According to the ITTF Board of Directors decision, as of 1st January 2008 the ITTF will implement at youth events a new racket control programme and protocol, using the Enez instruments to ensure that all rackets used by players are free of harmful volatile solvents (see the rules in the ITTF Handbook 2007-2008: 3.2.4.1 and 3.2.4.2).

Players will be invited to voluntary tests before the competition starts.

The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends all players to make certain that new coverings are aired 72 hours before use
