 CBS and CGS will be played in two stages. Groups of 3-4 players in the first stage with two players advancing to the KO. All matches best of 5 games.

JBD and JGD will be played in KO basis (best of 5 games)

CBD and CGD will be played in KO basis (best of 5 games)

Team events will be played in two stages, groups in the first stage and KO in the second stage.

Junior Team format: A-X, B-Y, C-Z, A-Y, B-X (3 players)

Cadet Team format: A-X, B-Y, Double, A-Y, B-X

Each ITTF affiliated Association is granted with up to 8 boys and 8 girls and up to 2 teams per event. Therefore, up to 12 entries may be accepted by gender and age category IF THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES ALLOWS THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE TO DO THAT. The decision will be taken immediately after the date of the final entry deadline.
 The Host Association is granted with the double of entries per event.

If cancellations occurs from that time till the time of the draws and are directly notified to the ITTF Competition Manager, the Jury may decide to accept merging the remaining players (i.e. if one player from team "A" and one player of team "B" of the Association XXX cancel their participation **BEFORE** the draw is made but after the Cancellation deadline, the Jury may accept to merge the remaining players of Team "A" and "B" in one team.). The same applies for doubles.

20. Racket Controls:

According to the ITTF Board of Directors decision, as of 1st January 2008 the ITTF will implement at youth events a new racket control programme and protocol, using the Enez instruments to ensure that all rackets used by players are free of harmful volatile solvents (see the rules in the ITTF Handbook 2007-2008: 3.2.4.1 and 3.2.4.2).

Players will be invited to voluntary tests before the competition starts.

The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends all players to make certain that new coverings are aired 72 hours before use
